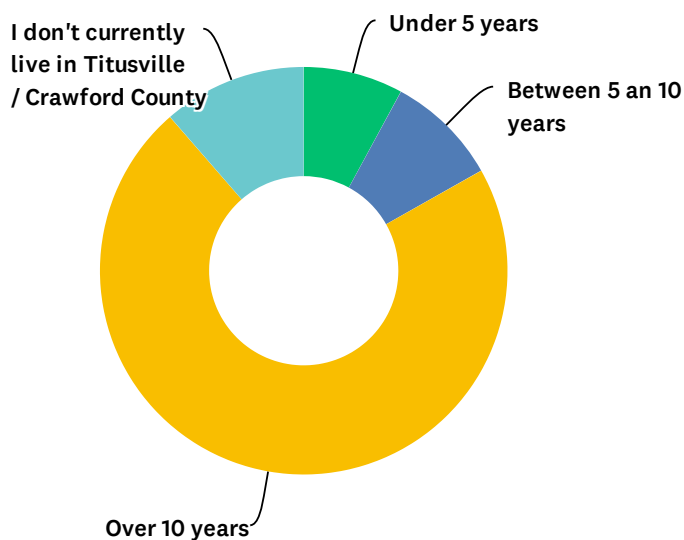


## Q2 How long have you lived in Titusville / Crawford County?

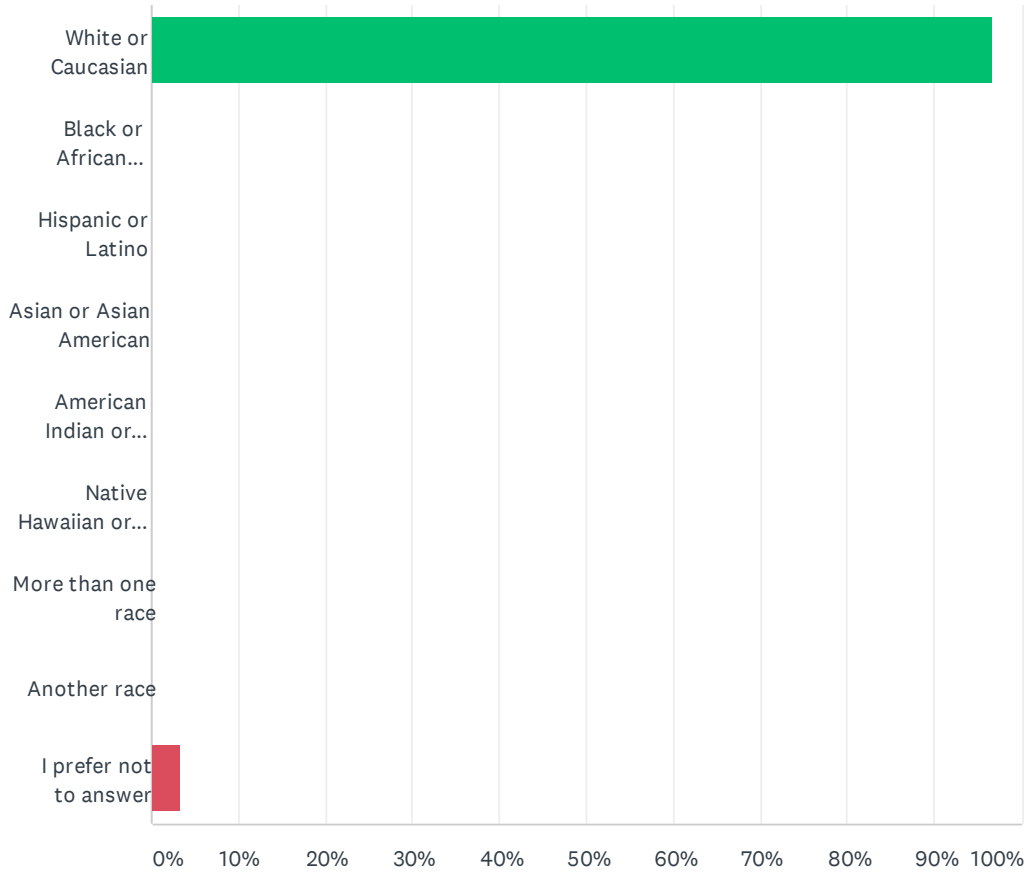

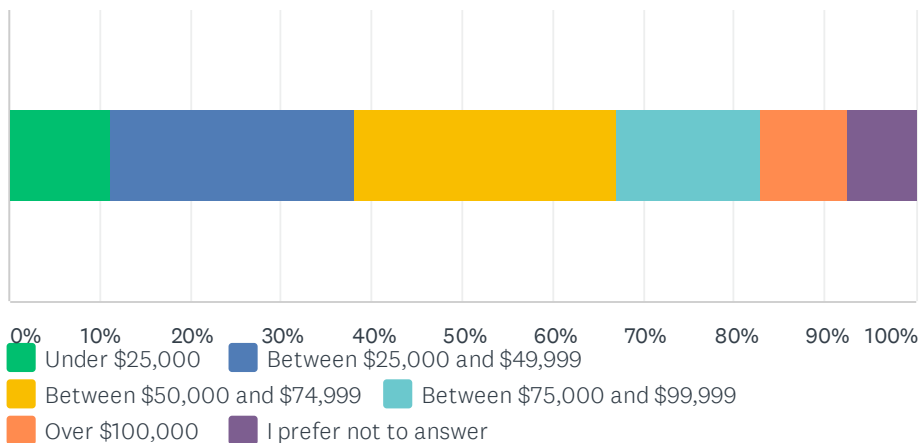

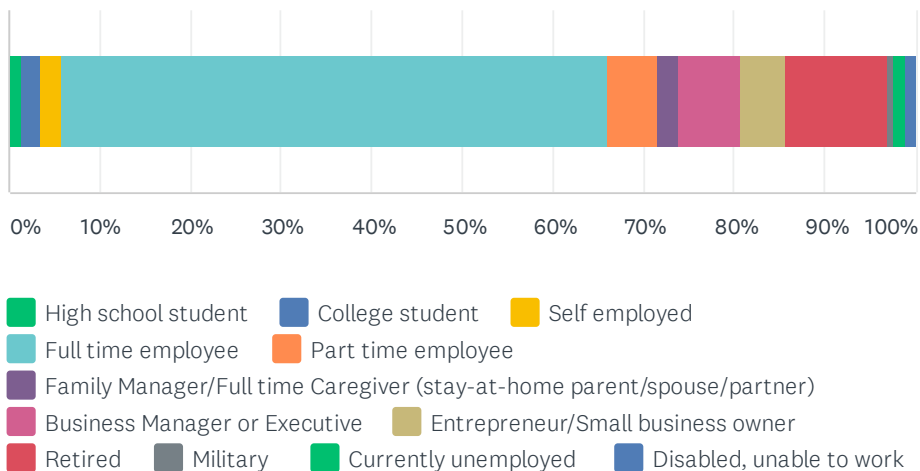

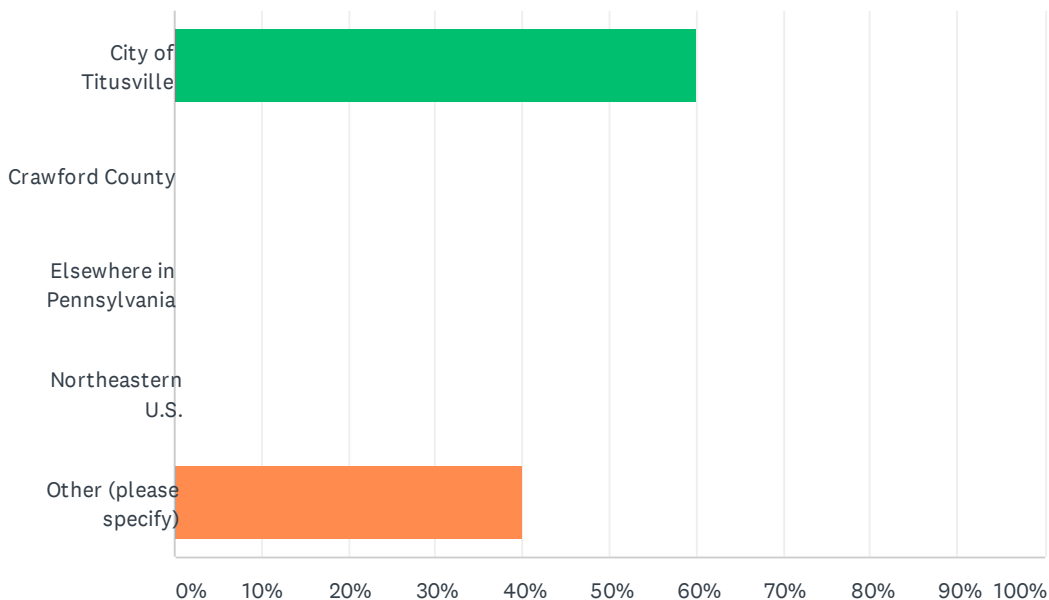

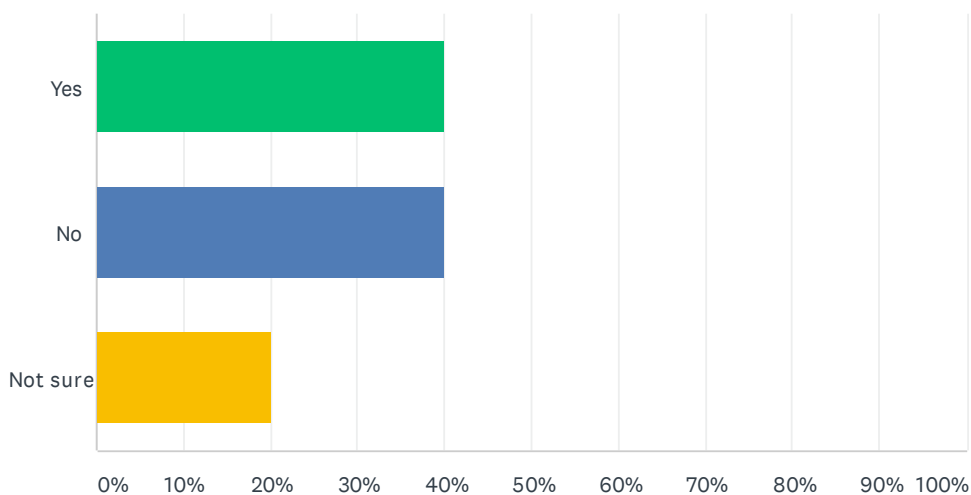

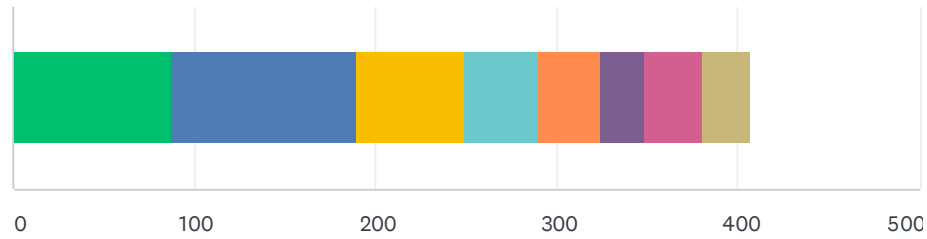
